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
Subject: Review of Post-Retirement Medical Scheme (PRMS)-reg.

This has reference to the requests received from superannuated employees with regard to relaxation in validity of prescription for prolonged treatment of diseases under para 6.5 (c) of PRMS.

2. Consequent upon a review, it has been decided to modify para 6.5 (c) of PRMS to the following extent: -

Extant Provision	Modified Provision
<i>The prescribed limits applicable for consultation fee, diagnostic/investigation charges etc. in the case of superannuated employees will be similar to that of a serving employee of the same status. Where the superannuated employees has claimed under the category "chronic ailments", and has produced a requisite certificate from the Authorized Medical Attendant, the prescription of the Authorized Medical Attendant prescribing medicines up to a period of 3 months would be considered valid.</i>	<i>The prescribed limits applicable for consultation fee, diagnostic/investigation charges etc. in the case of superannuated employees will be similar to that of a serving employee of the same status. Where the superannuated employees has claimed under the category "chronic ailments", and has produced a requisite certificate from the Authorized Medical Attendant, the prescription of the Authorized Medical Attendant prescribing medicines up to a period of 6 months would be considered valid.</i>

3. Other terms and conditions regulating extant GAIL PRMS Rules will remain unaltered.
4. This is issued with the approval of Competent Authority.
