## Subject: Review of Post-Retirement Medical Scheme (PRMS)-req.

This has reference to the requests received from superannuated employees with regard to relaxation in validity of prescription for prolonged treatment of diseases under para 6.5 (c ) of PRMS.

2. Consequent upon a review, it has been decided to modify para 6.5 (c ) of PRMS to the following extent: -

3. Other terms and conditions regulating extant GAIL PRMS Rules will remain unaltered.
