## **Subject: Review of Post Retirement Medical Scheme (PRMS)**

This has reference to Corporate HR Circular of even number dated 31.07.2019 notifying annual ceilings for Out Patient Department (OPD)/Domiciliary treatment as well as for Prolonged treatment of diseases under the PRMS.

2. The matter relating to rationalization of extant ceilings for OPD/Domiciliary treatment and Prolonged treatment for allowing flexibility to PRMS members in availing their entitlement as per their medical requirements with ease, as also for simplified processing/regulation of their medical claims has been examined by Corporate HR Department. Accordingly, it has been decided to allow PRMS members in availing their entitlement for OPD/Domiciliary treatment and Prolonged treatment of diseases under a combined annual ceiling as mentioned below w.e.f. FY 2023-24 and onwards:

- 3. In view of the above-mentioned rationalization of Annual Ceilings for OPD/Domiciliary treatment and Prolonged treatment, no carry forward of revised combined Annual Ceilings for FY 2023-24 and onwards to next financial year shall be allowed.
- 4. Other terms and conditions governing PRMS shall remain unaltered.
