# Subject: Post-Retirement Medical Scheme (PRMS)- reg

This is in furtherance to Corporate HR Department's Circular of even number dated 28.02.2017 notifying thereby the revised Post-Retirement Medical Scheme (PRMS).

- 2. Corporate HR Department was in receipt of references for reviewing the list of diseases/ailments requiring prolonged outdoor treatment in terms of the Para 6.5 of the Scheme.
- 3. Consequent upon a review, the list of chronic diseases under Post-Retirement Medical Scheme (PRMS) has been revised and the same is placed at **Annexure-I.**
- 4. Further, it has also been decided to include knee and hip transplants within the coverage of major organ transplant in the list of specified critical illnesses in terms of Para 5.1 of the Scheme.
- 4. Other terms and conditions regulating extant GAIL PRMS Rules will remain unaltered.
- 5. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority and comes into force with immediate effect.
